Kintore Konnect is also grateful for the Church's sponsorship for the next year.

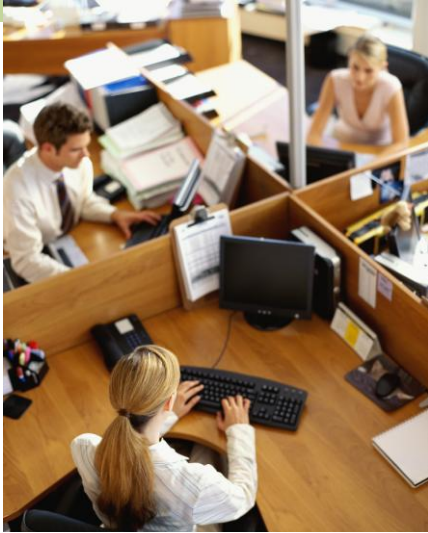
