

DOLL' CLOTHES 3 SIZES

	Small	Medium	Large
DOLL WAIST	19 cm	21cm	24 cm
DRESS WAIST	20 cm	22 cm	25 cm
DOLL HEIGHT	30 cm	32 cm	34 cm
SKIRT LENGTH	10 cm	10.5 cm	11 cm

(adjust length to fit your doll – skirt should be half way down legs)

AFRICAN DOLL DRESS

Double knitting. 4mm (N° 8) needles. Bright colours (2 for stripes)

Tension 2 st/cm, 3 rows/cm (20st, 30rows over 10cm)

You can work in a single colour or two colours.

If you are working the stripes, carry the wool up the rows on the wrong side.

SKIRT

Cast on 57/66/75 sts. 4 rows moss stitch

Work stocking stitch until skirt measures 10/10.5/11cm

WAISTBAND

[K 1, K2 tog] X 19/22/25 (38/44/50 st)

8 rows st st

ARMHOLES

Cast off 3/4/5 st. work 13/14/15 sts. Cast off 6/8/10 st. work 13/14/15 st. Cast off 3/4/5 st.

Sew up skirt

BODICE (Front and back alike)

Work 6/6/8 rows stocking stitch on 13/14/15 sts.

(k1 at each end of the purl rows to make a neat “garter stitch” edge to the bodice)

Cast off. (Leave a long end to use for crochet straps)

Repeat on other 13/14/15 sts.

SHOULDER STRAPS (Adjust to suit the size of your doll)

CROCHET 3.5mm crochet hook.

Using long end of wool, make 9 chain, attach to other bodice using a slip stitch.

Double crochet around neck and armholes. (optional)

KNITTED

Cast on 10 st. K 1 row. Cast off. Sew straps onto bodice



AFRICAN DOLL CARDIGAN

Double knitting. 4mm (No 8) needles. Bright colour. One button.
Worked in stocking stitch (st st) with moss stitch (ms) border.
You can omit the button hole and use a popper to fasten instead.
You can either sew together the shoulder seam or graft the stitches together.

Cast on 45/49/53 st

- R1 ms k1, p1 ... to last st k1
R2 (right side) Inc 1 st knit-wise. ms p1, k1 ...to last st. inc 1 st knit-wise (47/51/55 st)
R3 ms p1, k1 ... to last st p1
R4 Inc 1 st purl-wise. k1, p1, k41/45/49, p1,k1, inc 1 st purl-wise
R5 ms k1, p1, k1, p43/47/51, k1, p1, k1 (49/53/57 st)

BUTTON HOLE

- R6 k1, p1, sl 1,k1,psso, k42/46/50, k1, p1, k1
R7 k1, p1, k1, p42/46/50, inc in next st, p1, k1 (49/53/57 st)

SLEEVES

RIGHT FRONT

- R1 k1, p1, k1, k10/11/12. Cast on 5 st. Turn. (18/19/20 st)

Leave remaining 36/39/42 st on holder.

- R2 k1, p1, k1, p12/13/14, k1 p1, k1

SHAPE FRONT NECK

- R3 k1, p1, k1, k2 tog, k10/11/12, k1, p1, k1 (117/18/19 st)

- R4 k1, p1, k1, p11/12/13, k1, p1, k1

Continue decreasing at neck edge on alternate rows to 12/12/13 st

Work 4/6/6 rows without shaping. (18/20/20 rows)

Cast off OR leave 12/12/13 st on holder to graft. Break yarn.

BACK

- R1 Cast on 5 st, k23/25/27, cast on 5 st (33/35/37 st). Leave remaining 13/14/15 st on holder.

- R2 k1, p1, k1, p27/29/31, k1, p1, k1

- R3 k1, p1, k1, k27/29/31, k1, p1, k1

Repeat rows 2 & 3 five/six/six times, then row 2 (14/16/16 rows)

BACK NECK BORDER

k1, p1, k1, k6/6/7, [k1, p1] x7/8/8, k1, (ms 15/17/17 st) k6/6/7, k1, p1, k1

k1, p1, k1, p6/6/7, [k1, p1] x7/8/8, k1, p6/6/7, k1, p1, k1

k1, p1, k1, k6/6/7, [k1, p1] x7/8/8, k1, (ms 15/17/17 st) k6/6/7, k1, p1, k1

Cast off in pattern. OR in order to graft:

- R16 k1, p1, k1, p6/6/7, k1, p1, k1, Cast off 9/11/11 st in ms, k1, p1, k1, p6/6/7, k1, p1, k1

Leave stitches on holder. Break yarn leaving long end to graft.

LEFT FRONT

- R1 Cast on 5 st, k10/11/12, k1, p1, k1 (18/19/20 st)

- R2 k1, p1, k1, p12/13/14, k1, p1, k1

SHAPE FRONT NECK

- R3 k1, p1, k1, k10/11/12, sl 1,k1,psso, k1, p1, k1 (17/18/19 st)

- R4 k1, p1, k1, p11/12/13, k1, p1, k1

Continue decreasing at neck edge on alternate rows to 12/12/13 st

Work 4/6/6 rows without shaping. (18/20/20 rows)

Cast off OR leave 12/12/13 st on holder to graft. Break yarn leaving long end to graft.

Sew shoulders together or graft together. Sew sleeve seams together. Sew on button.
